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Analysis of Students' Feedback and Action Taken Report

M.M.Ghodasara Mahila Arts & Commerce College conducts feedback process for knowing viewpoints of the students, and their thoughtful and constructive feedback are used to make improvements in order to look for opportunities to improve overall institute performances including teacher's engagement with students in classroom to ensure excellence in teaching, learning and research. It is a healthy practice at M.M.Ghodasara College to obtain feedback from the students about courses and course facilitator. The feedback for the year 2022-23 was obtained course wise from students. The feedback was collected and collated at the department level and important suggestions / ideas given by the students for enhancing the curriculum and syllabi were listed out. For the academic the session 2022- 2023, 39 filled in responses course wise, teacher wise semester- wise were received in the structured feedback form.

The scoring of each item was on the basis of three-point scale i.e. each item student indicates his / her level of agreement by selecting appropriate option (Agree, Disagree, Strongly Agree). The total sample size of the data was **39**. Then the consolidated data by the departments annually submitted to IQAC, which in turn analysed and submitted to Principal office for their analysis and further action.








2. How would you rate the quality education imparted in the college.




3. How would you rate the course content delivery.




4. How would you rate the course curriculum for fulfilling your expectation.




5. How would you rate the academic initiatives taken by the college to bridge the gap between industry & academic.




7. How do you rate the relevance of your degree to your present job.




9. How do you rate the development activities organized by the college for your overall development.




10. How do you rate the motivation created by the syllabus to pursue post graduate/research in the particular topic.




11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you




12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.




17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.






18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
